From the South....

Greetings Brethren!!! We welcome Br. Kyle Crane to both our Fraternity and Lodge! Br. Crane became a member this past Thursday, May 30th. Congratulations to the Officers and Sideliners, both in their fine Degree work and taking the time to attend! Also, behind us, is the Abelskiver Breakfast, which was reported to be a great success! Yours truly was not able to attend, as a reunion of my active-duty ship, I served aboard...some 52 years ago had already been booked and paid some time ago. For those of you who are not familiar with those little 'pancake balls', they used to be somewhat of a tradition many years ago in Glendora Lodge. Wor. Jack Margison, PM was the person who spearheaded this (usually) annual event at his home. Abelskivers are made with a batter, similar to pancake mix...a bit sweeter, perhaps. They are made in a cast iron skillet with 7 dimples for the batter...filled just over halfway. When the bottom and sides of the batter starts to firm up, they are 'rotated' in the dimple...with the batter formerly on top, now on the bottom...and that firmer 'bottom' now on top. Periodically rotated to ensure the ball is cooked all the way around. Seven Abelskivers out, seven more dimples to fill and cook. Each batch of 7 takes approximately 7 minutes to cook. From the Abelskiver mix Wor. Steve Pashby provided; I was able to make 120 which were delivered to the Lodge in advance of breakfast. More Abelskivers were actually made...but had imperfections in one form or another. So, with the 'mess ups', some 150+ balls were made. Took about 4 hours all said and done. As I was cooking them, I was reminded of the 'Perfect' and 'Rough' Ashlars in our Lodge Room...one to the north side of the first step to the dais; one to the south of the dais on the first step. While they were (and we are) all Abelskivers (or men) seeking to become that perfect (or presentable / servable little ball) Man...we all have imperfections, despite outward appearances of being 'perfect' or flawless See you next month!
